

## **Health Partnership Agreement**

In the best interest of our community's health, we have established guidelines to help reduce risk of spreading COVID-19. It is vitally important that we work together to keep our community healthy.

Guidelines for the school are explained in <u>MHFC School Plans 2020-21</u>. All staff have been fully trained in accordance with these guidelines and the school is committed to vigilant adherence and monitoring thereof. Additionally, all staff are certified through Texas A&M in 'Special Considerations for Infection Control During COVID-19'

It is the responsibility of parents and staff to ensure <u>good health practices</u> while away from school and to immediately <u>communicate pertinent information</u> to the school.

## **Health Practices:**

Parent Signature

Before coming to school, check for symptoms and stay home if any of the following are present:

Fever (100' F or higher) or Chills

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Muscle or body aches

Loss of taste or smell

Congestion or runny nose

Cough

Fatigue

Headache

Sore throat

Diarrhea

Nausea or vomiting

- Wear face masks in public settings (not recommended for children under 2 years of age).
- Reinforce healthy hygiene habits:
  - Frequent and effective hand washing: <u>Link to video tutorials</u>

- Practice and promote covering mouth/nose when sneezing/coughing. Cover mouth and nose when needing to cough or sneeze (use tissue and dispose after each use or, cover face with the interior part of your elbow).
- Practice social distancing in public and avoid large social gatherings.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick, even inside your home.

## **Immediately Communicate Pertinent Information:**

- Stay home and notify the school if you or a family member is showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19.
- Report to the school, any contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 (within the past 14 days).
- Notify the school if your child or any family member has recently traveled to a location experiencing high rate of transmission
